will host its College Skills Clinic on April 1, 2012. This clinic is designed to provide high school and prospective student athletes training experiences that will help prepare them to play college basketball. It will give them the opportunity to learn new skills, build on their fundamentals, develop new strength training ideas, and compete in five-on-five scrimmage games.

Current Lions players and assistant coaches will be offering instruction to participants and assisting with the College Skills Clinic. Each participant will receive a Penn State Altoona basketball t-shirt and a clinic workout packet that they will use to track their progress throughout the day.



Billy Clapper

The clinic will be directed by Lions Coach Billy Clapper who recently finished his third season as the head coach at Penn State Altoona. Clapper is a central Pennsylvania native and began his coaching career at Penn State Altoona as an assistant in 2005 after graduating from Youngstown State University. He then had coaching stints at Indiana State and the University of Pittsburgh Johnstown before returning to Penn State Altoona in fall 2009. During his first two seasons, the Lions have qualified once for the AMCC tournament (2010) and two of his players have earned All Conference Honors, one has earned All Region Honors.
